

Advanced Directives are documents that let your family and doctors know what kind of medical care you would want if you were no longer able to speak for yourself. Due to the 1990 Patient Self-Determination Act, hospitals are expected to inquire if you have any Advance Directives. Advanced Directives are documents such as a Living Will, Medical Power of Attorney and Health Care Proxy.
